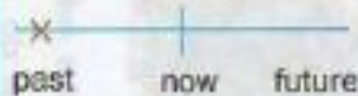

I **wrote** a letter *last week*.

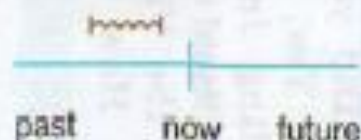
... **V2** ...



Past Progressive

We **were watching** a film
at 5 pm yesterday.
Tom **was writing** letters
from 5 to 7 pm yesterday.

Present Perfect

I **have already watched** this film.
Tom **has written** two letters
this week.

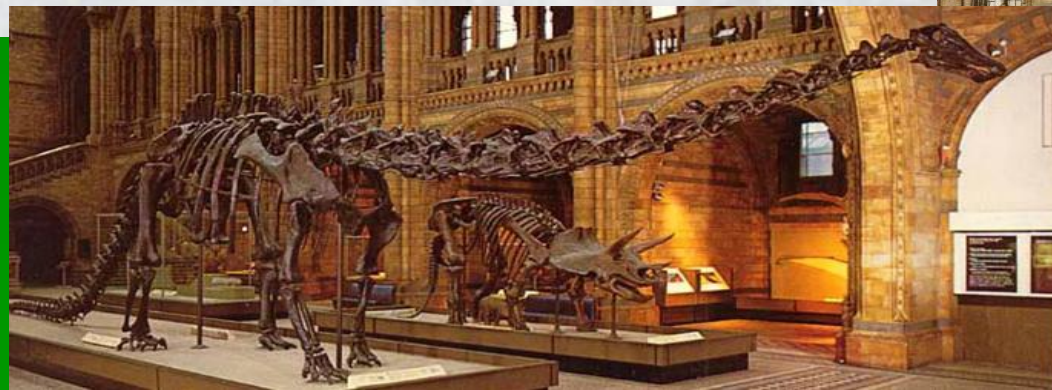
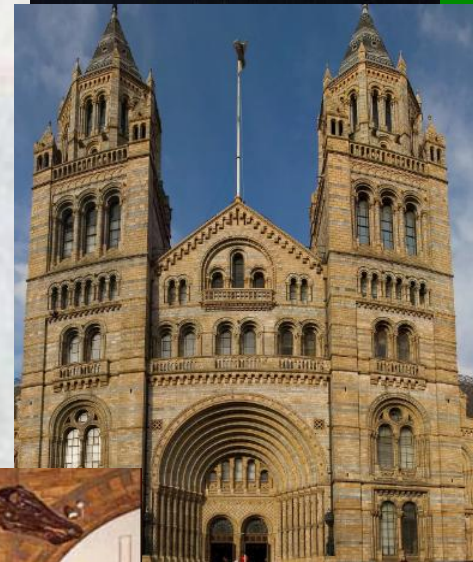
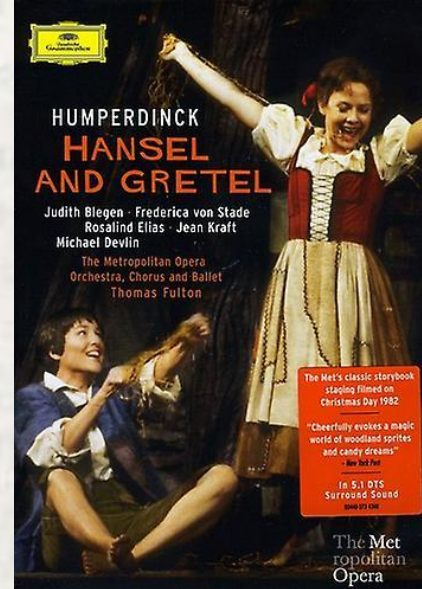
Melanie: I've got a *Hansel and Gretel* film and I (watch) it for an hour yesterday evening.
