

**Yes:** you are a very, very friendly person. You have all rights to be called the best friend. You have a lot of friends, real friends.



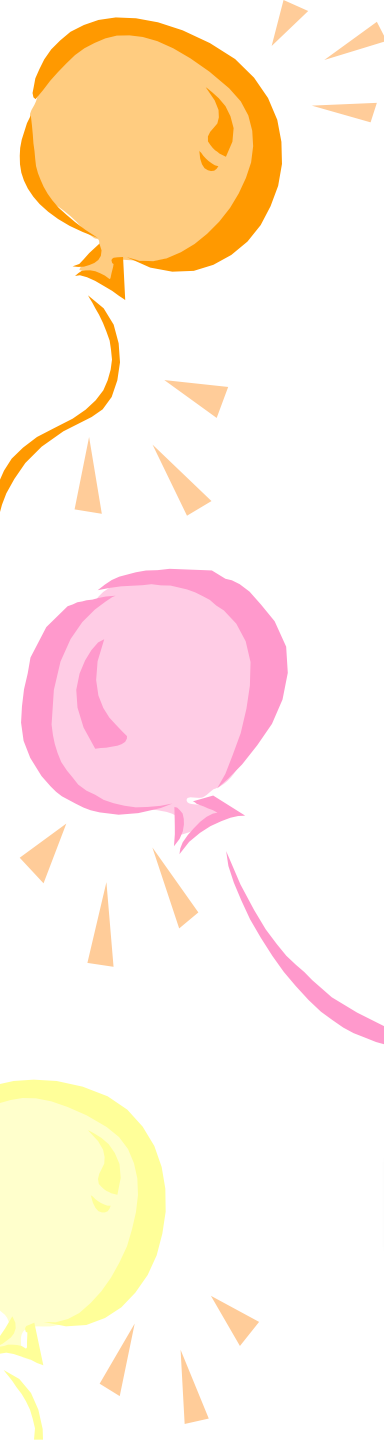
**Yes > No:** you are a friendly person, but sometimes you quarrel with your friend. You are the 1<sup>st</sup> to make peace.
